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Unit 5 Integrated Art and Design Research, Ideas and Methods

Feedback on progress:

Your ideas development / sketchbook:

_Good record of ideas but think about how you communicate your project process; annotate and add thumbnail photos, print key images of secondary research and add to your sketchbook alongside your ideas.

_Your design for the stroller is based on observations of people and space; you have a good ability to identify a problem and come up with a solution. Consider how you would explain that visually.

(As part of research you could go to stores?)

- _Use colour, explore line weight and try using promarkers to test how you communicate in your drawings.
- _Do more model making, as this is a new method of idea development process for you; explore more materials during the project process.
- _You have done very good illustrations of ideas in your sketchbook; it work really well.
- _Your Drawings are becoming stronger and communicate better as you are starting to add colour. Yet It's still difficulty to understand scale (size of your product).
- _Strong idea development process. Design idea are great but work more or structural / details of you designs.

Research on Workflow and in sketchbook:

You have done some good research so far but this is not in depth; refer to each project brief's bibliography and start gathering more references in relation to each project. You need to expand awareness of contemporary art and design practice.

Your reflection on Workflow: this is consistent and well organised. Make sure to always question is order to be critical and analytical in your reflective writing.

Action Plan and Advice:

_Remember that you should have research uploaded for Self Portrait, This Place, as well as your Group 1 specialist project. As a guide you should expect to upload around 20 images for a 1 week project, some of these may also be in your sketchbook. If you are confused about research or reflection look in the Workflow tabs in the Course Information area on Workflow where there are lots of useful resources. You can also review the Contextual Practice slides on Moodle.

- _Expand research references (may not be as specific to what you are designing)
- _Make sure you add analytical comments to research
- _More work on contextual practice is needed.
- _think about layout of workflow (all looks fine so far)
- _you talked about Getting stuck and not sure how to move on; you are now understanding process and how model making can show direction (process, having tutorials was helpful, asking questions about target audience). Make sure that you record your reflect on you learning experience so far!
- _Make sure outcomes are clearly presented in the sketchbook; i.e self-portrait.
